Testing for a Fire Protection License with the Office of the State Fire Marshal

Effective August 25, 2023, the following exams are administered by the Delaware State Fire School as part of the process to obtain a license with the Office of the State Fire Marshal:

- Test based on the current edition of the Delaware State Fire Prevention Regulations.
- Test for Fire Alarm Signaling System Class V license, based on the current edition of the Delaware State Fire Prevention Regulations and the currently adopted editions of NFPA 72, National Fire Alarm Code, and NFPA 101, Life Safety Code.
- Test for Fire Suppression Class IV license, based on the currently adopted edition of NFPA 13D, Installation of Sprinkler Systems in One- & Two-Family Dwellings and Manufactured Homes.
- Test for Fire Extinguisher License, based on the currently adopted edition of NFPA 10, Portable Fire Extinguishers.

All tests are open book exams.

It is the applicant's responsibility to bring the appropriate exam reference materials with them for the exam.
