

## **Opening a Restaurant (Place of Assembly)**

Our agency recommends that you contact the division office for the county in which you wish to open your restaurant prior to signing any lease agreement:

### **New Restaurants**

For new buildings -or- a new tenant space that was not previously a restaurant, the following shall be protected throughout by an approved, supervised fire sprinkler system:

- **Dance halls.**
- **Discotheques.**
- **Nightclubs.**
- **Bars with an occupant load of 50 or more occupants.**
- **Restaurants with an occupant load of 50 or more occupants.**
- **Assembly occupancies with festival seating.**

In addition to the fire sprinkler system, the following additional permits may be required:

- Listed and approved commercial cooking hood(s).
- Listed and approved commercial cooking fire suppression system.
- A fire alarm system.

Once open, an annual inspections of all fire protection systems and an annual assembly license is required for any location with an occupant load of 50 or more occupants:
